Ella admitted she had done better than expected with her GCSE results.

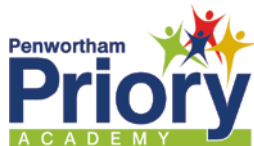
“In my mocks I got Grade 5 in both my English subjects and I got Grade 6 on both so that may change my plans for the future.” *Ella*
