Senior Prefect Maya was the top performer at Priory. She achieved three Grade 9s and four Grade 8s and a Level 2 Distinction Star in Engineering.

“I expected a 5 or 6 and I got a 7 so that was amazing!

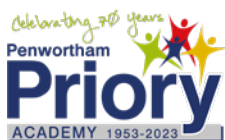
“I got five Grade 8s as well. I want to go to Newman College and study History, Geography, Politics and Maths. I want to be a lawyer.” *Ben*
