What do Governors do?

The governing body works with the executive leaders to set the vision, ethos and strategic direction of the school. It holds the executive leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and its pupils, the performance management of staff, and oversees the financial performance of the school, ensuring money is spent correctly and for the good of all pupils.

Who are the Governors?

Governors are volunteers drawn from various areas of the community. They challenge and support the school in a proportionate, fair manner on behalf of all children and families. At Priory we have places for up to 16 Governors: 6 community governors, 3 co-opted governors, 4 parent governors and 3 staff governors. Governors usually serve for a minimum of 4 years, but many enjoy the role and continue long after this initial term of office. All governors are required to be DBS cleared.

Information about our Governors and the Committees:

- At Priory the governing body delegates certain responsibilities to two sub-committees: the Resources Committee which meets 4 times a year (and is primarily concerned with managing the schools budget) and the Curriculum and Standards Committee which meets 3 times a year (and is responsible for educational standards).
- Additionally there are 3 full governors meetings per year.
- The current Chair of Governors is Dr Phil Range and the Vice-Chair is to be appointed shortly.
- The Chair of the Resources Committee is to be appointed shortly, and the Vice Chair is Stephen Grafton.
- The Curriculum and Standards Committee is chaired by Dr Phil Range and the Vice Chair is Peter Faulkner.
- Staff governors offer a school employee perspective. The current staff governors are Peter Faulkner, Cheryl Barker and Elle Diamond-Bugler. Alex Willis is an Associate Governor.
- There is also a small sub-group of members and external advisors that make up the Academy Trust.
- The governors are supported by Sue Spencer, Clerk to the Governors.
