CULTURE DAY – HENNA CONSENT

As part of our Culture Day event on Friday, 1 May, students will have the opportunity to use henna to draw mehndi patterns on their hands.

Henna is a natural dye made from a plant and applied to the skin. It will remain on the skin for a few days, but it is not permanent. It will however, permanently stain clothing if it comes into contact with it before drying. Black henna will not be used. Please note that an allergic reaction is possible, but uncommon.

The activity will take place at break/lunchtime in the Auditorio from Monday, 27 April to Thursday, 30 April. To cover resources, this will cost £2 per person which can be paid in cash on the day.

If your child has expressed an interest to take part in this activity and you consent to the application of henna, please complete and return the permission slip below to me before Thursday, 30 April.
