DUKE OF EDINBURGH EXPEDITION PLANNING SESSION – MON, 11 JULY

There is a planning and preparation session on Monday, 11 July in Hu4 from 10am till 3pm. On arrival at school, pupils should head to reception. Please note, pupils should wear the boots they are wearing for the expedition.

Pupils will be lent all of the equipment they need - there is plenty of everything – however pupils should bring a packed lunch for the day, water bottle, cutlery, wooden spoon, plastic or metal plate, bowl and mug. We will also provide pupils with some basic food to have a go at cooking using Trangias and gas cookers which they will be using whilst away.

In the planning session we will go through the route maps and route activity sheets which will be completed in preparation for the walks on Sunday, 17 July and Monday, 18 July. We are booked in for a second night on the Monday for the pupils to have a celebration evening at the camp site and then return to school by 10.30am on the Tuesday.

The pupils will be given another full itinerary which will ask them to be at school on the Sunday for 7.45am fully packed for the day having had their breakfast. Pupils must have a packed lunch for the Sunday, food to cook for the Sunday evening and basic breakfast foods as well as refreshments to add to their packed lunch for the Monday expedition.
