Berlin / Krakow WW2 Education Trip (July 2027) - Expression of interest

We are currently exploring the possibility of an international educational trip to Germany/Poland with a focus on World War 2 history. The purpose of this letter is to provide preliminary information to gauge interest.

We propose a 6-day, 5-night trip to depart on Wednesday, 7th July and return on Monday, 12th July 2027. This visit is designed to provide students with a powerful and meaningful insight into key historical events of the 20th century, particularly relating to the Holocaust and modern European history.

There will be places for 44 pupils at the estimated cost of £1399 per person. Accommodation, travel costs, insurance and a trip hoodie are included along with half-board meals and entrance fees to attractions. Pupils should also allow for approximately £25 per day to cover lunches and any personal spending.

The visit will include a range of guided educational experiences, such as:

- Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial and Museum (guided visit)
- Schindler Museum in Krakow
- Wieliczka Salt Mine
- Wannsee Villa
- Berlin Olympic Stadium
- Key Berlin historical landmarks, including: Brandenburg Gate, Berlin Wall Memorial, Topography of Terror, Holocaust Memorial
- Berlin Story Museum ("Hitler: How Could It Happen?" exhibition)
- A bowling activity as part of the trip experience

This promises to be a highly valuable and memorable educational experience, and we very much hope to be able to offer this opportunity to our pupils.
