We are pleased to inform you that we are organising an exciting co-curricular educational trip to Liverpool for students studying Geography and Religious Education (RE). This trip is designed to enrich their classroom learning through real-world experiences and will take place on Wednesday, 10 December.

Purpose of the Trip

Religious Education Students

RE students will have the opportunity to visit the magnificent Liverpool Cathedral, where they will explore its architecture, history, and spiritual significance. This visit will support their understanding of places of worship and religious expression, key components of the RE curriculum, led by Mrs Ham.

Geography Students

Geography students will explore Liverpool One and The Albert Docks, two areas that exemplify sustainable urban regeneration. These locations are directly linked to the Changing Cities topic in the GCSE Geography syllabus and complement the work undertaken in class for their Liverpool case study. Students will observe first-hand how Liverpool has transformed its urban landscape through sustainable planning and development.
