### **Performing Arts London Trip (March 2027)**

We are pleased to be able to offer 30 places on a Performing Arts residential trip available to all year groups.

We will travel by coach leaving from school early morning on Tuesday, 9 March 2027 and head to London. On arrival in London, we will have a workshop with industry professionals before enjoying an evening meal and a West End show. The following day, Wednesday 10 March, we will enjoy a trip around Tate Modern and the V&A Museum (these might change due to availability). We will then head for an evening meal and to another West End show. Day 3, Thursday 11 March we will have some shopping time before the journey home.

Pupils will have their breakfast for Wednesday and Thursday as well as their evening meal on the Tuesday and Wednesday included, meaning they would only need to bring a packed lunch for the travel down and money for their lunches on the Wednesday and Thursday.

The cost will be approximately £569 per person. Accommodation, transport, theatre tickets, entrance fees, breakfast and evening meal is included for this three-day trip.

This trip is an added bonus to such a diverse curriculum already offered at Key Stage 3 and 4. The experience will provide a valuable insight into the professional workings of world class theatre and orchestras, and pupils will gain significant cultural experiences that will enhance their life skills.

To attend this trip, please make a **£75 deposit payment via SCOPay by 17 July** where you will also be asked to provide consent. The following payment schedule must be kept:

**By confirming your consent for this trip, you enter into an agreement with Penwortham Priory Academy to complete all payments by the published deadline/s. Should your child be unable to go on the trip, for whatever reason, all monies agreed must continue to be paid.**

**If the place can be filled with another pupil, a refund will be given, less the administration costs to change the place. In the event of an insurance claim, all monies would be refunded to the payee only after settlement of the claim and receipt of the refund in school.**

**Please note: If your child cannot attend the trip (personal choice) OR a deterioration in your child's behaviour/attendance results in their place being revoked, any monies already paid will be non-refundable. We will always do our best to fill the place, but this cannot be guaranteed.**

**This place is subject to your child adhering to the school's behaviour policy from now until the trip. If your child fails to follow this, then Mr Bullock (EVC) and Miss Howell (Trip Leader) will discuss your child's suitability for this trip, and if needed your child may be removed from the trip and their place allocated to someone on the reserve list.**

We will have a parents/pupils meeting and resource pack to give out once we have secured sufficient numbers to ensure that the trip goes ahead.
