LONDON RESIDENTIAL TRIP – June 2026 (3 DAYS)

We are pleased to be able to offer 30 places on a Performing Arts residential trip exclusively available to Year 10 and Year 11 pupils. If spaces remain, we will extend the invitation to Key Stage 3 pupils.

We will travel by train, leaving from Preston station early morning on Thursday, 25 June 2026 and head to London. On arrival, we will have some shopping time before enjoying an evening meal and a West End show. The following day, Friday 26 June, we will tour the Tate Modern and the Science Museum (these destinations might change due to availability). We will then head for an evening meal and to another West End show. Day 3 – Saturday, 27 June we will take part in a West End theatre workshop with people who have worked in the West End themselves.

Pupils will have their breakfast provided for Friday and Saturday as well as their evening meal on the Thursday and Friday, meaning they would only need to bring a packed lunch for the Thursday as we travel down, and money for their lunches on the Friday and Saturday.

The cost will be approximately £510 per person. Accommodation, transport, theatre tickets, entrance fees and breakfast is included for this three-day trip.

This trip is an added bonus to such a diverse curriculum already offered at Key Stage 4. The experience will provide a valuable insight into the professional workings of world class theatre and orchestras, and pupils will gain significant cultural experiences that will enhance their life skills.

If you would like your son/daughter to attend this trip, please make a £40 deposit payment via SCOPay by **Friday, 28 November** where you will also be asked to provide consent. The payment schedule for the remaining £470 would be split into 6 payments: Payments on/by 31 December 2025, 31 January 2026, 28 February 2026, 31 March 2026, 30 April 2026, 31 May 2026. Prior to the trip, please advise the school of any updates to emergency contacts, medical and dietary information that we should be aware of in advance.

Please note that by consenting to your child's participation in this trip, you agree to be responsible for the full cost. This includes non-refundable deposits and remaining balances, regardless of whether your child ultimately attends.

There will be a parents/pupils meeting and resource pack to give out once we have secured sufficient numbers to ensure that the trip goes ahead. If you have any questions in the meantime, please contact me via email at f.howell@priory.lancs.sch.uk.
