HENNA CONSENT

As part of our Ramadan Hub activities running throughout the month, students will have the opportunity to use henna to draw mehndi patterns on their hands.

Henna is a natural dye made from a plant and applied to the skin. It will remain on the skin for a few days, but it is not permanent. It will however, permanently stain clothing if it comes into contact with it before drying. Black henna will not be used. Please note that an allergic reaction is possible, but uncommon.

The activity will take place at break and lunchtime in EN1 (Mrs Robinson-Ali's room) from Monday, 10 March to Friday, 28 March. To cover resources, this will cost £2 per person which can be paid in cash on the day.

If your child has expressed an interest in this activity and you consent to the application of henna, please complete and return the permission slip below prior to them taking part.
