THEATRE TRIP 'SIX' - WED, 4 FEBRUARY 2026

The Drama and History department have teamed together to create a sensational trip to see Six the Musical. We are pleased to be able to offer 80 places for the theatre trip, at the Liverpool Empire Theatre.

Winner of the Tony Award for 'Best Original Score' and 'Best Costume Design', double winner of the Whatsonstage Award for 'Best West End Show' and a Gold-Disk winning album, this sell-out Tudor takeoff has 'an incredibly strong and powerful message' (The Australian) and is 'pure entertainment' (New York Times).

From Tudor Queens to Pop Princesses, the six wives of Henry VIII take to the mic to tell their tales, remixing five hundred years of historical heartbreak into an 80-minute celebration of 21st century girl power. These Queens may have green sleeves but their lipstick is rebellious red.

The price will be £39.00 including the ticket and return transport. The group will travel by coach and leave school at around 15.45pm. We expect to return to Priory approximately 8:45pm. It is essential that pupil have a fully charged mobile phone with them and I must also ask that you organise your child's collection from school well in advance.

Pupils may wear their own clothes that are appropriate for the trip, but they are to remember they are representing the school and therefore must uphold the Priory standard. Pupils will need to bring a packed tea which can be eaten on the coach. Pupils may also bring a small amount of spending money/bank card if they wish to buy refreshments or souvenirs at the theatre or alternatively they can bring their own snacks.

The closing date for places is 18 July 2025 when a £10 non-refundable deposit is required to secure the ticket, however, this will close earlier if places are filled. Payment must then be made in full by 18 December 2025. If you would like your child to attend the trip, please make the required payment via the school's online payment system, SCOPay, where you will also be required to provide parental consent. This replaces the need to complete a reply slip.

Prior to the trip, please inform the school of any recent updates to emergency contacts and medical conditions we may not already be aware of.
