NEU Strike Action 27 April – Arrangements for Learning

Please be aware of the following arrangements for learning during the national teacher strike this Thursday, 27 April.

All Year 11 pupils are expected to attend school on this day. They will complete lessons and revision sessions.

Pupils in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 should complete lessons according to their usual Thursday timetable. The following guidance has been provided by their teachers:

English	Work will be set through Teams and Seneca for 10EW4 and 9W2
Maths	Students should work on Sparx - completing 'compulsory' homework as well as additional tasks such as 'XP Boost' and 'Target' questions. Explanatory videos are embedded within each question.
Science	For Science, work will be provided on Seneca. There will be an assignment added in the same format as the weekly homework, with the title 'Thursday 27th April 2023'. This will be located under the Assignments tab. Your child can access Seneca using their school email, the default password is seneca2020 though they may have changed this – please ask them to message their teacher via Teams before the day for any password resets.
Computing/ICT	Work will be set on Teams
Art and Design	Art and Design pupils will access work on their Teams group. The work set will specifically link to the scheme of work and may even entail completing a piece of classwork that is planned for later in time. Any work set will not require materials other than what is required for homework. All completed work must be brought back into lesson to add to sketchbooks.
Music	Music theory and listening work will be set on Teams
Food Technology	Work will be set on Teams for Year 10
