FRENCH EXAM PREPARATION AND REVISION

I look forward to seeing many of you at parents evening on Wednesday, 19 April.

I wanted to make contact before the holidays as this two-week break is a good opportunity for lots of preparation and revision for the speaking exams which take place week commencing 8 May.


I thought it would be useful to provide you with an outline of how and what your son/daughter should be revising over the Easter break and beyond.

- **Listening papers** – they have been provided with five past papers to complete. The listening files are on Teams, and they also have a copy of the transcripts.
- **Reading papers** – they have five past reading papers to complete.
- **Speaking exam** – revision for this part of the exams should focus on all three themes. Pupils should refrain from focusing too much on their chosen theme and ensure they are confident and could hold conversations on ALL THREE themes.

Many pupils find this preparation quite overwhelming and need a clear structure for their revision. We have discussed this in class and have provided them with an example of a revision timetable. We are fully aware they have other subjects to revise, so we encourage little and often! A timetable for their revision is motivating and much less overwhelming.
