GCSE GEOGRAPHY - LIVERPOOL FIELDWORK & INTERVENTION TRIP

Your child is invited to attend an intervention and fieldwork trip to study several urban sites using two zones within Liverpool. Once we have completed the day's fieldwork, we will finish the day by spending approx. two hours in Liverpool One and the Albert Dock combined.

The pupils do not need to wear uniform however, they should be smart as they will be speaking to a guide and members of the public. They will also require a waterproof coat as we will be completing the work outside.

Pupils must bring a packed lunch. They should also bring their own phone so they can take photos which they will later need to download to build a portfolio of evidence to complete Paper 2 and Paper 3 tasks. Pupils will need basic writing equipment including a pen and pencil.

Pupils will only be permitted to go in designated areas and follow the school's code of behaviour at all times. Pupils will be under direct supervision when we are walking through Liverpool undertaking urban transects, and when at both the Albert Dock and Liverpool One sites. When at Liverpool One, pupils will get 90 minutes to eat at one of several key takeaways/ restaurants and have contact through their mobile phone. Pupils will have 'free time' whilst in Liverpool One and have a designated meeting point. Pupils will be told to stay within the designated area.

We will leave school at 8:40am and return to school by 4:30pm. Pupils must either be collected or arrangements made by yourselves for their safe return home. Please also ensure that we have up to date medical information and emergency contacts.

The cost of the trip is £12.00 which can be paid through our cashless online system, SCOPay*. This cost covers printed materials, a ferry trip across the Mersey and return transport from school.

Pupils will work in buddy groups of four and must stay in those groups throughout the journeys and trip. Pupils must adhere to basic Covid rules; we will ask all pupils to wear a mask on the minibuses and when they enter buildings, shops and restaurants. Pupils cannot and must not break any of the school's codes of behaviour. Illegal substances cannot be carried, used and bought whilst on the visit, this includes cigarettes, tobacco and alcohol as well as all nonprescribed drugs. (All trip and residential risk assessments require us to inform you of the codes expected of each pupil). It is ultimately, each individual's responsibility to ensure that they are respectful to other members of the trip and that they follow instructions with dutiful care.
