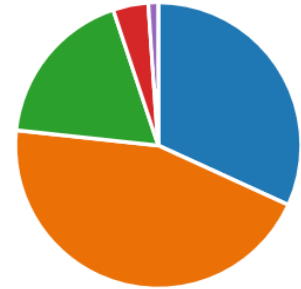

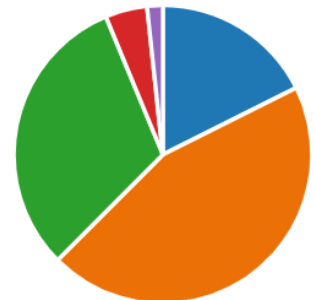

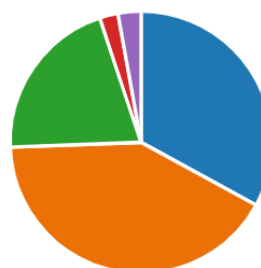
Thank you for highlighting areas here you do not feel safe. We have included your responses and what we are doing about it.

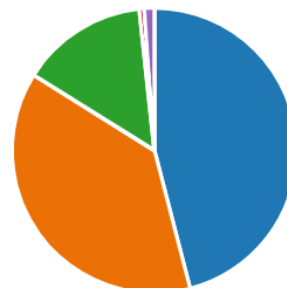

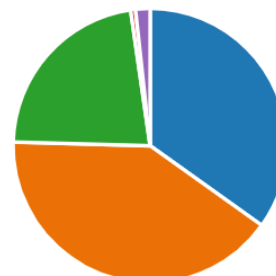
