Pupil Voice 1 Outcome and actions	There are some pupils who sometimes use the incorrect toilets Staff have been reminded to restrict use to the correct year group at all times
Pupil Voice 2 Outcome and actions	A couple of Year 9 pupils are leaving food in places they shouldn't Mrs Farley has informed Mrs Ham and she will look into this and speak to individuals.
Pupil Voice 3	Some Year 7 girl's toilet locks aren't working
Outcome and actions	This should now be resolved. The Estates Team has added the checking of toilet locks and toilet seats on to their daily check list.
Pupil Voice 4	Some older pupils are still not conforming to school culture in the Restaurant queue at times
Outcome and actions	Catering staff haven't witnessed anything and would intervene if they saw this. Staff on the external queue do watch for this and intervene when required. If pupils see issues they must report it to an adult straight away
Pupil Voice 5	Arbor is hard to use for some and some find they cannot stay logged in.
Outcome and actions	Settling into using any platform can be unsettling and challenging. You should find it easier to use, once you use it more. The system regularly logs out to ensure the system is secure to prevent anyone entering the platform and accessing your information.
Pupil Voice 6	Can points be reduced to 15 on Bedrock? It can take pupils varying times from 15 mins to 2 hours. Can this be personalised?
Outcome and actions	Ms Beswick says: "No, it's set as a quota by Bedrock and if it taking longer we advise you split it over the week. The quota is the amount the programme knows will make an improvement on your learning. We also are awarding the top 10 from each year for completion each half term."
Pupil Voice 7	Please can we have Tag-Rugby as an extra-curricular activity?
Outcome and actions	Mrs Bullock says: "Unfortunately, due to staffing, we are currently struggling to accommodate this but we are looking at getting a rugby coach in school from September."
Pupil Voice 8	Reading Plus – The blue line is frustrating.
Outcome and actions	The moving line is set to ensure you read at an appropriate speed to ensure you absorb what you have read. If this speed causes issues, you need to speak to your teacher.

Outcome and actions Unfortunately not. Schools are only allowed two fried food options per week as they are

seen as unhealthy.

Pupil Voice 3 Toilets can still be a problem at times with other students using them instead of their own

Outcome and actions Duty staff have already been reminded to only allow the correct year group in the toilets.

We will reissue the reminder.

Pupil Voice 1 The toilets are sometimes closed

Outcome and actions It is not always possible to 'staff these toilets due to staff being on duty. You do have

access to the new toilets, so please use these.

Pupil Voice 2 During Ramadan – Reminder about prayer rooms

Outcome and actions Mrs Ham has highlighted this during RE lessons

Pupil Voice 3 The Vending machine near the Sports Hall is not working

Outcome and actions Issues need to be raised immediately to Mr Bolton or the Business & Finance Team.

This has been added to the 'Every' task management platform by Mrs Ham so should

be fixed imminently.

Pupil Voice 4 Are we sure the red cards points are being given fairly?

Outcome and actions All staff have been advised regarding how to use these fairly. Should you see anything

which appears unfair, please let Miss Burbridge know

Pupil Voice 5 Please can we have a fruit bar in the canteen and Soreen bars?

Outcome and actions The Catering Team say that an 'open bar' is a hygiene risk at present. It would require

staffing. As soon as the team are able to recruit more staff this then becomes viable. In the interim, it is suggested you use the online ordering and if there is something specific you want, please do ask the Catering Team. Soreen bars will need investigating

against the Healthy Eating guidelines so the team will do this.

Pupil Voice 1 Please can we have mac and cheese served more often.

Outcome and actions This is now on the two week menu cycle for the future.

Pupil Voice 2 We loved the American pancakes. Can they have them more often please?

Outcome and actions In the future we are bringing back themed weeks. The American pancakes will be back

as part of the appropriate themed week.

Pupil Voice 1 Please can all meat served in school be Halal

Outcome and actions All meats are Halal including the Friday jumbo sausages. However, the normal

sausages, being pork, are not.

Pupil Voice 2 Please can we have the curry on the menu more often?

Outcome and actions Catering said, "It will be on once a week from after Easter".

Pupil Voice 4 There seems to be not enough hot food for everyone

Outcome and actions The Catering Team say that there is always hot food coming back from the Bistro, so

whilst this is not the case, they will continue to monitor it.

Pupil voice which was vaised for Senior Leadership...

Please can we have an update on the nets on the MUGA?

Mr Eastham's response:

"We are considering this, however it is a long process. Planning permission is needed and there is wildlife to consider (birds). We are hoping to get the Astro upgraded and it will be part of this work."

Please can we have an update on the nets on the yard for Year 8 football?

Mr Eastham's response:

"We are reluctant to do this as there is potential for the ball hitting the buildings, windows etc. There are also the same considerations as the MUGA. I will speak with Mr Bolton and Mr Gee in the first instance regarding whether this can be considered in the plans."

Please can we have an update on the gueue rail outside the POD?

Mr Eastham's response:

"We have decided that we are not going to install one. Issues with queuing are the exception rather than the norm as Mr Gee or I are there most days. The vast majority of pupils are sensible and queue with expected respect. The Pod is heavily used at the weekends and evenings and we feel that this will detract from how this looks and works for our lettings."

Please can we have an update on meal deals?

Mr Eastham's response:

"In the second half term we are moving to a new catering system. There will be a number of aspects that will be changing in relation to this and there is the intention of having meal deals. The new Catering Managers are keen to bring the meal deal back and conversations are happening about this. It will be important for the student council to feedback to us."
