#### Dear Parent/Carer/Pupil

Thank you to everyone who has completed the online form to confirm acceptance of your place. I am really pleased that your child will be joining us here as a pupil at Penwortham Priory Academy from September 2025. The closing date to complete the acceptance form has now lapsed, so if you haven't yet submitted your form, please do so as a matter of urgency as we have several pupils on our admissions reserve list hoping for a place.

This letter contains lots of important information and a checklist for you to keep hold of so that you know what to expect and when information will be available to you.

#### **Data Collection forms and Parent View**

I will soon start my transition visits into primary schools and will be visiting each school, either virtually or in person, before the end of the Summer term to meet with your child and their teacher to discuss their attainment, attendance and general attributes as a pupil. I will also speak to your child about what happens when they come to Priory and hopefully have a good chat and ease any worries they may have about moving to secondary school.

However, I am also keen to hear your view. As part of our standard data collection process, which is required to be completed by law, there are a few short questions to answer about your child's skills and strengths. I therefore ask that you complete the data collection form, in full, by 23 May.

You will receive the data collection form via email using our 'Applicaa' programme over the **next few days, if not already.** Please ensure you check your junk folders for this if not received around the date of this letter.

#### Buses

We operate a Cottam bus service in order to transport your child to and from school. As is normal at this time of year, the current route and price are under review and subject to change. Whilst we expect any alterations to our transport arrangements to be kept to a minimum, you will be notified of these details before the May half term break and asked to register your interest for this route.

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


# **Summer School**

There is a section on the data collection form for you to book a place on our Summer School which will run on Tue, 19 August and Weds, 20 August. This exciting opportunity is free and only open to all incoming Year 7 pupils. We hope that as many pupils as possible attend – even if just for one of the days (although we hope you can join us for both). All enrolments need to be completed by Friday, 23 May 2025, via the data collection form.

## Uniform

Our uniform information can be found on the school website, and in our Parent & Pupil Handbook, a copy of which will be sent out in future correspondence. However, below is the list of our local stockists should any parents wish to get a head start:

#### Ties

The school tie (worn by house colour) is only available direct from school and can be purchased at the New Parent & Pupil Evening on Weds, 2 July, at a cost of £6 in cash.

## Lockers

All pupils will be issued with a locker which will be sited in their year group area. Lockers cost £5 for the full five years. The locker is accessed via a key code and pupils will be guided in setting this up. They will need to choose a 4-digit numerical code that is easy for them to remember. We recommend they make a note of the number they choose and keep it in a safe place in case they forget it. More information will be provided when your child starts in September.

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## **Online Payments System**

We operate an internet payment system which allows parents/carers to make payments for all school purchases such as meals and trips. All payments must be made via this secure online payment facility, using a debit or credit card. All parents can have access and details, including your unique portal code, inviting you to set up an account will be provided once your child has started with us in September.

## **ID Cards**

All pupils will be issued with an ID card and lanyard in their first week. This is to be worn as part of the school uniform and used to make payment at the tills for any food purchased in school. Pupils will also use their ID card to sign in and out of school if leaving for an appointment/sickness etc during the school day. Replacement ID cards can be purchased via the online payments system for £1 if needed.

## Lunches

At Priory, pupils have the choice to purchase food and drink directly from the dining room to eat in or take away using their ID card to make payment (cash cannot be accepted), which is linked to the secure online payment system. Details will be given to your child during the first week of term.

As the online payment system can only be set up once pupils have started with us, **we ask that pupils bring a packed lunch for their first week in September.** 

## Arbor

Arbor is an online application that enables parents and carers to have an immediate overview of many aspects of school life, including behaviour, attendance and communication. Once registered, parents and carers can view information specific to their child. The behaviour module provides a real time view displaying positive comments and points awarded as well as informing you where aspects of behaviour may be limiting progress. Children will also be able to access their own accounts to view information. A letter will be issued to you in the first few weeks of September on how to set up your parent account.

I hope that you find all this information useful and it answers any questions you may have regarding your child's start here with us at Penwortham Priory Academy.
