

The school day – ‘Learn to succeed’

The school day is designed to uphold our ‘Priory Standard’ and develop our **pupils’ value set**:

- We are **Ready to succeed**
- We have the right **Attitude to Learning to succeed** (By upholding our ‘Attitude to Learning in Lessons Charter’)
- We have the right **Character (Skills) & Culture (Attitudes) to succeed**

The day itself starts with lesson 1 at 8.40 am.

We have an ‘**arrival window**’ between 8.20am and 8.40am, allowing pupils to come into school and get **ready to succeed**.

During this arrival window, pupils can come into school, visit their lockers, and get ready for the day ahead. By 8.40am, they must be in their classroom ready for the start of lesson 1 to begin.

Registration is taken at the start of every lesson throughout the day.

In every lesson, pupils are expected to have the right **attitude to learning to succeed**, by upholding our ‘**Attitude to Learning in Lessons Charter**’.

At 10.40am, pupils go to their pastoral vertical house form group with their form tutor. At the start of this session, pupils are expected, without instruction from their form tutor, to have their planner out on the desk and start reading their accelerated reader book. This session is a pause in the day to ensure staff can focus on the **pastoral care** of the pupils in their form group.

At break and lunchtime, pupils are expected to uphold the ‘**Priory Standard**’ in terms of their behaviour outside of lessons, always.

At the end of the day, pupils go to their **Learning for Life lesson** taught in their year group area. This lesson focusses on their **personal development**, to ensure our pupils have the right **character (skills) & culture (attitudes) to succeed**.

This then brings the school day to an end at 3.05pm for years 7, 8 and 9 and 3.10pm for years 10 and 11.
