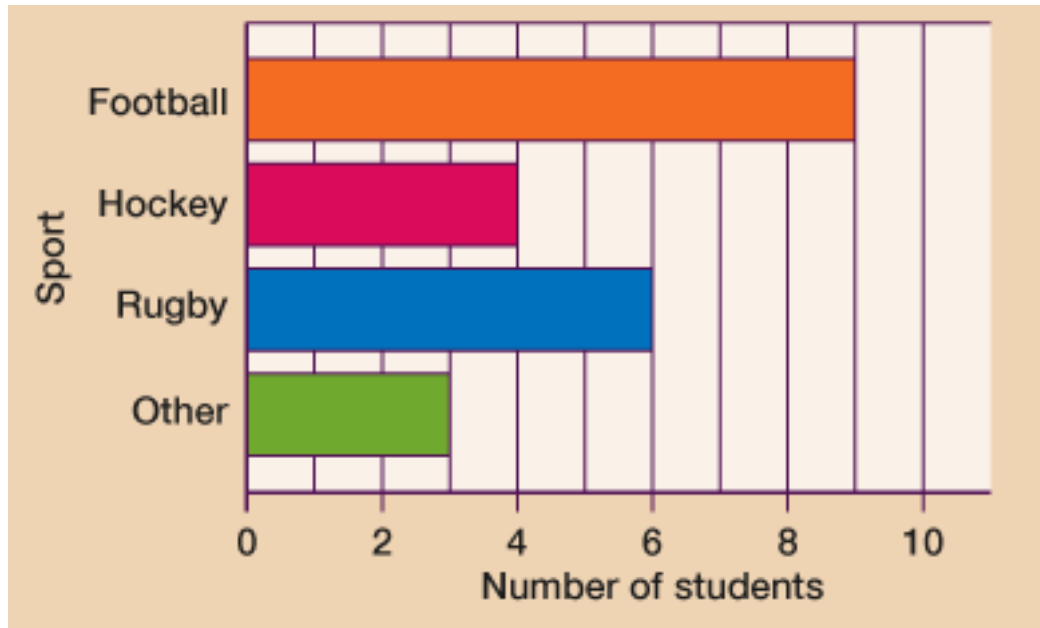
Make sure you have a think about what you would like us to do when we are all back together in school and we can talk about all our ideas on Monday.

## Mathematics (TBAAT interpret data on a pictogram)

Bar chart to show the favourite sports of children in Class 6.



Remember to look carefully at the scale when reading a bar chart! You will see on this scale that the numbers go up in steps of 2, so if the bar is half way in between two of the numbers, you will need to find that number in between the ones written on the scale.

- 1) Which sport was the most popular? \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) How many children voted for rugby as their favourite sport? \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Which sport had 4 votes? \_\_\_\_\_
- 4) How many children voted other? \_\_\_\_\_
- 5) How many children voted for hockey and rugby altogether? \_\_\_\_\_
- 6) How many **more** children voted for rugby than hockey? \_\_\_\_\_
- 7) How many **more** children voted for football than rugby? \_\_\_\_\_
- 8) Which sport would you vote for as your favourite? \_\_\_\_\_
