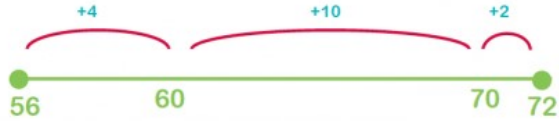


Mathematics – Practise subtracting by finding the difference using a number line (see worksheet stuck in homework book)

Bronze Class Homework Grid Autumn Term 2

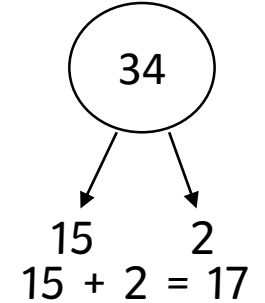
