

Pool House Community Primary School Bronze Class Curriculum Map – Summer Term

English

The children will also have daily SPAG sessions to allow us to further develop our learning on spelling rules and grammar.

We will be reading the story of 'Ottoline and the Yellow Cat' before planning and writing our own mystery story sequel. We will also explore various legends including George the Dragon Slayer. Alongside learning the features of a legend, we will plan and write our own legends.

During daily reading skills lessons, we will explore various text types to develop our inference skills alongside literal retrieval.

Religious Education

In RE this term we will be learning about Buddhism and Christian Ceremonies. In our Buddhism unit, we will be learning about Buddhist beliefs, meditation and where Buddhists go to worship. Our Christian Ceremonies unit will focus on celebrations such as weddings, baptisms and exploring the beliefs and values of God and Jesus. We will also make comparisons with our own beliefs.

PSHCE and Well-Being

This term we will be learning more about different types of bullying and what to do if you feel yourself or a friend is being bullied. We will also be learning about being a good citizen and celebrating people's and communities differences and beliefs.

Mathematics

In Mathematics we will continue to develop our written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods alongside using these to progress our problem solving. We will be learning how to tell the time on an analogue and digital clock, including converting between the two and we will explore data interpretation, where we will collect and present data using tally charts, pictograms and bar charts. We will also continue to consolidate and learn new times tables.

Physical Education

Our PE lessons will take place on Monday and Wednesday each week. During this term we will be developing our games skills including throwing and catching, working as part of a team and communicating with other team members. We will learn key skills needed to play cricket and football. Making the most of the outdoors, we will explore orienteering in our Outdoor Adventure Unit.

Science

Science this term will focus on two topics: Rocks and Fossils and Plants. We will learn about the parts of a plant and their uses, grow and observe our own plants and learn more about seed dispersal and pollination. Our learning about rocks and fossils will focus on learning about the three types of rocks and how they are produced and look further into what a fossil is and how they are formed.

Computing

This term in computing we are learning about collecting data in our unit 'We are Researchers'. We will use Google Forms to create our own surveys, collect the data and then look at ways to present this data. In the final summer term we will be learning about drawing and publishing skills using Microsoft Publisher and Paint.

Art and Design Technology

In Art this half term we will be looking at Mandalas, including their origination, different ways to design them before designing our own. In DT we will enjoy plenty of food tastings as we explore how pizza and bread is made before designing and making our own pizzas and sandwiches.

Humanities

In History this half term we will be learning about The Romans, including their invasion of Britain, how their presence influenced our lives today, what techniques and equipment they used during battle and what life was like for a Roman Soldier. We will also be learning about significant individuals including Emperor Hadrian and Boudicca. We will also be learning about the development of Railways in our Railways unit, looking at how railways and trains influenced and changed our local history.

French

We will be learning about different modes of transports, our body parts and animals in French this term. The children will begin to learn key words in French and build up their vocabulary bank, as well as learning to say simple sentences in French.

Spellings will be handed out every Friday and will be tested the following Friday.
