Rainbow Class Curriculum Map – Spring Term

English

In English, we will explore new topics including 'Twisted Tales' and 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We will continue to write fiction and non-fiction texts and will be reading a wider variety of stories, books and reports. We will continue to learn Phonics and have our weekly spelling test.

Religious Education

Mrs Bradley will be teaching our Religious Education lessons and we will be learning all about the Jewish faith. Our studies will include their beliefs and some of their special stories. We will also be learning more about Easter.

Humanities

In Geography this term, we will be learning about China including locating it on a map, learning about the culture and comparing it to England. In History, we will be learning about significant nurses including Florence Nightingale.

Mathematics

In our daily Mathematics lessons, we will be discovering more about place value through 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. We will look at shapes and fractions. We will be learning core skills involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and we will be having regular times-table sessions.

Physical Education

We will be exploring games, using our basic throwing, and catching skills. In the second half term, we will be learning more about dance and creating our own routines.

Science

We will be learning more about everyday materials and conducting a series of experiments on which materials are most practical for various jobs. We will then be exploring plants; this includes knowing the parts of a plant, conducting experiments into plant growth.

Computing

We will be using the computers once a week and continuing to develop our basic skills. We will be exploring two topics - taking better photographs and researching a topic.

Music

We will be exploring new instruments and working in small groups to create a piece of music. We will be learning Easter songs and traditional music.

Art and Design

In the first half term, we will be learning about the artist Claude Monet and we will be creating our own versions of some of his work. In the next half term, we will be creating moving pictures and pop up cards.
