English

During our daily English lessons we will be continuing to learn our basic skills in reading and writing. Our topics will include The Shang Dynasty, The Iron Man, Poetic Language and The Grand Tour. We will be completing extended writing tasks weekly and refining our grammatical skills in our daily SPAG lessons. Children will be tested each Monday morning on their weekly spellings.

Religious Education

As part of our important religious studies we will learn more about the religion of Sikhism and about the religion of Hinduism. The class will learn more about the key beliefs of these faiths. We will be taking part in collective worships and understanding how religion can teach us about our own lives.

History and Geography

In History we will be studying all about Crime and Punishment throughout time thinking about the similarities and differences between then and now. In Geography we will be studying the Water Cycle and Flooding – focusing on how flooding is caused and the effects it has on communities.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Mathematics is taught daily as we continue to learn our basic skills and develop learning of the four key operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication). Our topics in Summer Term include Addition and Subtraction, Counting and sequences, Fractions and Decimals, Volume/Capacity and Mass Position and Area and Multiplication and Division.
