In English this half term we will be studying units of work on traditional tales, poetry looking at pattern and rhyme and information booklets on animals.

We also have daily phonics sessions. Please encourage your child to discuss the new sounds they have learnt as well as segmenting and blending their sounds whilst reading their reading books.

Music

Our music lessons will consist of our discovery of pitch and whole School singing.

Mathematics

Throughout this half term we will be looking at counting and representing numbers, addition and subtraction, 3D shapes and place value. The children will develop their number skills further with problem solving activities in the classroom through enhancement in continuous provision.

Curriculum Overview - Spring Term

PSHCE and Wellbeing

We will be setting targets and personal goals, exploring the wider community and relationships with our peers. We will also discuss loss, family networks and how we can help others.

Art and Design Technology

In our Art lessons we will be studying buildings and in DT we will be investigating homes and creating their own with internal features.

PE

This term our topics are gymnastics and games. Please ensure that your child's full kit is in School every day with their names on every item. Our P.E lessons are on **Mondays** and **Thursdays**.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at the four seasons and weather. They will learn about the four different seasons and the months in which they fall, as well as what the weather is like in each season.

Science

In our Science lessons we will be looking at seasonal changes and plants. We will investigate what a plant needs to grow and why there are seasonal changes. We will be developing our investigation skills throughout the term as well as using scientific terminology.

Computing

We will illustrate stories and the children will learn how to search for images on the Internet safely.

RE

Our focus this term will be Sikhism and Christianity and the Easter story.

History

We will be studying The Great Fire of London. We will be using a variety of sources to explore how our lives are different to those in the past.

Spellings will be handed out every Friday to be tested the following Friday.
