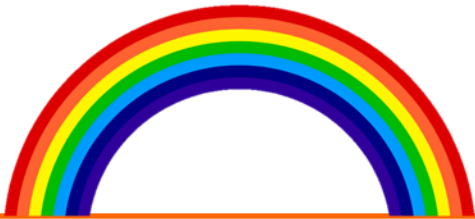


Multiplications

Number Bonds to 10

A number bond to 10 is a pair of numbers that always add together to make 10. E.g. $5 + 5$, $6 + 4$, $7 + 3$. Make a poster of all your number bonds to 10.
