Addition Number Bonds

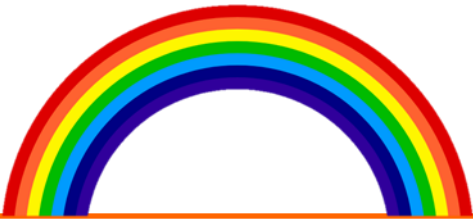

Phonics

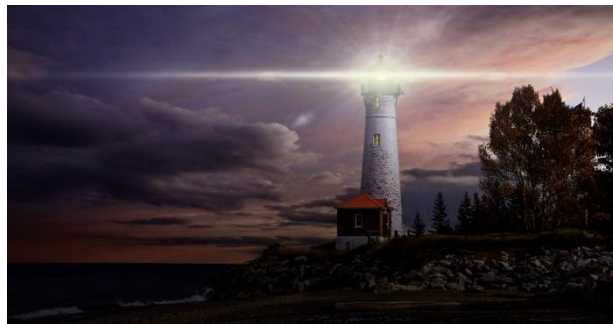
Stuck in your books is a list of Real Words and Nonsense Words. Read them aloud and colour the Real Words in green and colour the Nonsense Words in red.
