



Carry out your own research into The Battle of Britain. As part of your research try and find six interesting facts about the battle. Lets see how many facts we can find altogether as a class!

Create your own WW2 propaganda poster. Rather than focus on evacuation as in Year 5, you have the freedom to theme your poster on whatever you would like – growing own food, reminding the public about 'loose lips', making use of scrap metal etc.

Who was Winston Churchill?
Carry out research into this famous historical figure and create a fact file about him, detailing the key events in his early life, his contribution to the country during WW2, at least one of his famous quotes and an image of him.

World War Two

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Imagine that you are a child who was alive during The Blitz bombings. Write a diary entry explaining what you had to do during the bombings, how you felt and what the area you lived looked like the next morning.

Draw and label the uniform that an RAF or Luftwaffe pilot would have worn during The Battle of Britain in 1940. Consider whether the uniform is for a male or female pilot and colour your uniform in appropriate colours for the time period.

The homework grid for this half term links to our current history topic about WW2 in Britain, following on from our evacuation topic last year. Homework is optional for this half term but I would love to see as many people taking part as possible.
