Make a poster to remember the twelve months of the year and the order they go in. For an additional challenge write out how many days each of the months have.

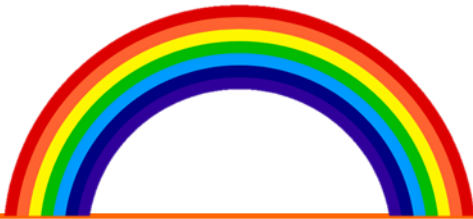
