Which 3D shapes can you find in and around your home? You can draw or take pictures to put in your books, to show where you found them. Please label them to describe their properties, e.g. how many corners they have.

Write a recount of your first day in Moonbeam class. How did you feel? How did you get to school? Who were you looking forward to seeing the most? What activities did you enjoy doing and why?

Draw a portrait of a friend or family member and include labels for their features.

Homework Tasks

Create a picture out of different 2D shapes and write down how many of each shape you have used.

Create your own animal along with a description about them. What qualities will they have? What will they look like? What do they eat? Can they fly?

Think creatively when making your animal. For example, it could be a painting, model or made out of lego.

What would you like to know about the adults in your new classroom? Write down five questions for Miss Wilson and Mrs Dorota. They might even reply to you with the answers!

Please encourage your child to discuss the phonics sounds they have learnt each week, as well as working on their segmenting and blending when reading their reading books at home.

Please read with your child each night for at least 15 minutes and sign their reading record.
