Challenge: Can you use adjectives with your labels?



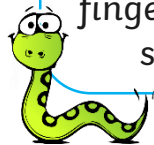
### Doubles

### Writing

### Phonics

Challenge: Can you write a sentence or question including any of your words?

### Reading

Read your favourite book at home and write me an explanation of why it's your favourite book. Your explanation could include which part you like the most, your favourite character or any illustrations that you like.
