

Science – TBAT name the basic parts of a simple circuit.

Use the short BBC Bitesize video added to our working wall to learn all about the different parts of a simple circuit and how we show these on paper.

Draw some examples of electrical symbols and diagrams.

History – TBAT understand how the Anglo-Saxons shaped Britain.

Research the Anglo-Saxons and the changes they brought to Britain. Focus on their culture, religion and society – what changes did they make to Britain?

Maths – TBAT learn and recall multiplication and division facts for the 6 times table.
