Rainbow Class Curriculum Map – Autumn Term

English

In English, we will be writing a variety of exciting stories and learning about new topics such as 'All About Orang-utans', 'Worry Monsters' and 'The Jolly Postman'. We will still be working on our Phonics and learning new spellings each week. We will also be reading lots of new books.

Religious Education

Mrs Bradley will be teaching our Religious Education lessons and we will be learning all about the Christian faith. We will explore their place of worship, their core beliefs and some of their special stories.

Humanities

Our first topic in Geography is the local area including map skills. In History, we will be learning about the Gunpowder Plot, where we will explore the life of Guy Fawkes and create some creative writing about the original Bonfire Night.

Mathematics

In our first term, we will be mastering place value and learning to count beyond 100. We will be learning some new methods for addition and using our number bonds to 10 and 20 with ease. We will explore 2D and 3D shapes and learn some multiplication and division rules.

Physical Education

In our first half term, we will be learning all about dance and we will be choreographing our own movements. In the second half term, we will be refining our gymnastics and balance skills.

Science

How we grow and stay healthy – we will explore basic needs of human survival, look at exercise and diet and look at how medicines can be helpful. Animals Survival and Growth – we will explore animals, their offspring, and the basic needs of animals such as water and food.

Computing

As we start our learning in Year 2, we will be going back to basics and learning how to use basic programmes such as Google Search, Microsoft Word and Microsoft PowerPoint.

Music

Mrs Bennett will be joining us for our Music lessons this year, she will be teaching us some traditional songs and we will learn how to play an instrument.

Art and Design

In the first half term, we will be exploring the work of important sculptures and creating our own sculptures. In the second half term, our class will become a little health restaurant as we prepare seasonal salads.
