Dear parents, carers and guardians,

Re. 1. Parental survey; 2. PE kit in the summer term;

As there have been so many learning points for all of us this year, it would be helpful if as many parents as possible could complete our standard survey: [Quick Parental Survey](#). Please use the final question to pass on any information you wish to make us aware of.

We are aware that while parents' evenings appear to be more popular online than on site, a consequence has been that we have not been able to consult with parents with the normal level of frequency.

On another matter, and considering the continued uncertainties about the easing of COVID restrictions:

- (i) unfortunately, we still need to exercise caution regarding after school activities;
- (ii) rather than return to full use of changing rooms after half term, we will cautiously edge forward using them for PE lesson registration to set the tone and direction of lessons in a very controlled manner with face coverings. This arrangement will be reviewed in the second half of the summer term. We will therefore continue with our current approach and **permit students to wear PE kit as uniform only on those days** where it is timetabled. This is contrary to my [summer term letter 10.05.21](#). All other aspects will still hold.

Thank you to those parents who have expressed their views about other benefits of this approach. We shall consider these in the context of the parental survey returns.

Thank you once again for your on-going support. The consideration that your children have shown for clinically vulnerable members of our community are a credit to you.
