## Return to school 2022

This term, in spite of the high number of both staff and student families affected by illness, our staff body has worked tirelessly – covering additional lessons, to ensure the school has remained open and functioning well. Where colleagues in other schools have had to alternate year group home-learning, I am relieved to say that this has not been an option we have needed to consider.

All schools in the BCP area have been required to undertake 'extraordinary measures'. These include the requirement for all students to undertake on-site Lateral Flow Tests on their return to school. There is little point speculating about further changes to local and national guidelines this week and the inevitability of additional updates during the Christmas holidays.
