- Moreover, some aspects of the park require guests to wear masks. Please ensure your child has one on their person to use in these areas.
- Students will be able to leave their belongings on the bus. They will not have access to the Sixth Form area/lockers on our return to school. We would recommend bringing a small additional bag to be taken around the park.
- All belongings are your child's responsibility whilst on the trip.
- There will be an opportunity to buy some refreshments at Thorpe Park.
- Any student in receipt of free school meals can collect their lunch at break time from the canteen.
- Please ensure that if your child requires medication, they also have this with them. This also includes travel sickness medication.
