GCSE Examinations May - June 2023

Year 11 students have continued to impress us with their attitude towards their examinations. The vast majority have shown a seriousness in approach and a maturity on the day. Having passed a major milestone with some of their core subjects, it's really important they take full advantage of your support and keep the momentum going with a clear, structured schedule over half term. Please ask them to share their plan for the week. It should show a minimum of 30 hours planned, scheduled in 20-30 minute slots with short breaks. Practice tests and past paper questions should form a key aspect of this. Highlighting and re-reading is of negligible value.

GCSE's have become far more specialised – involving content that historically used to be on A Level papers. This is the reason school attendance with subject specialist-led revision is so important.

Students must continue to attend school in full school uniform after half-term, and it is absolutely essential that their clear plastic pencil case contains: 3 x black pens, 3 x green pens, highlighters, pencils, pencil sharpener, rubber, ruler, protractor, compass, and calculator. Our uniform policy prevents unnecessary distractions, meets the exam board requirements, and ensures students are solely focused on their exam.
