Students will be able to collect their results from the **M&M Hall** and continue to **enrol in to sixth form**, or speak to any of our specialist staff regarding their alternate post-16 destinations.

For instances where results cannot be collected in person, we must have written confirmation from the **student** (not parent) of the named person who will **collect your envelope on your behalf**. Please state the **forename and surname** of the person collecting your envelope and their **relation to you** (you may state they are a friend if no relation).

All written requests must be provided to the examination office using the email exams@poolehigh.poole.sch.uk by the end of term.

Awarding this year have centred upon the 'Poole High School Finals' which has allowed all students fair opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in each subject. We will provide information on the appeals process on results day, however we cannot overstate the levels of care taken with our awarding process in terms of moderation and standardisation undertaken internally and externally.
