Dear parents, guardians and carers

RE: Return to school for key worker provision

Thank you for being so responsive in supporting your child with the Lateral Flow Tests at home. Please can I encourage you to continue establishing this routine with your child. Please go through the 'expectations' that are outlined in the letter that has gone to all parents so that your child is fully prepared for their return next week.

The provision for key worker students is still available next week. However, please note that as your child will be starting to undertake LFTs at home, they **will not** be attending the onsite test at the same time as their peers as they are at a more advanced stage.

Your child will however be attending their normal school day as outlined below. We look forward to welcoming students back – following the guidance outlined in the accompanying letter. We ask that students arrive at 8.25am for a normal school day until 2.55pm.

On arrival from Tuesday 9 March they should go straight to their classroom at 8.25am. They will not be collected from reception.
