

Bromyard Grammar School Foundation Grants 2026



Are you an ex-pupil of the Queen Elizabeth High School in Bromyard and live within the catchment area of the school? Are you in or entering into Higher Education or are you about to undertake training for a job, vocation or apprenticeship? Are you aged between 18-25? (16+ for apprenticeships). If you can answer yes to these questions then you may be eligible for a grant from the Bromyard Grammar School Foundation to go towards the costs of travel to or attendance at college/university (not 6th Form) or other expenditure relating to courses, under the criteria below.

BROMYARD GRAMMAR SCHOOL FOUNDATION NOTES ON EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

The Governors of the Foundation are able to make awards or grants for the following purposes:

- Higher education at college, university or other educational establishments (including professional and technical but not 6th Form)
- Financial assistance (on leaving school, college, university etc) to assist in preparation for or entry into a profession, trade or calling, including purchase of tools, instruments, books or membership of a relevant professional body
- Travel in this country or abroad to pursue further education
- Financial assistance for study of music or other arts
- Otherwise to promote education including social and physical training

The Governors are required by the terms of the foundation scheme to give preference to applicants who are, or who have been, students of Queen Elizabeth High School, Bromyard. Therefore to qualify as beneficiaries within the terms of the Foundation Scheme applicants **MUST**

- Have been born or resident in the catchment area of the Queen Elizabeth High School, Bromyard and attended the school.

- Be aged 18 - 25 years of age on 31/10/26 (or, in the case of apprenticeships 16-25)

Applications are considered by the Governors in November of each year, therefore all completed forms must be submitted **no later** than midnight 31st October 2026 to: bromyardgsf@gmail.com (electronic signatures are acceptable). Late applications will not be considered. Awards are usually paid in December. The amount of award will vary each year according to the number of applicants and how well the foundations investments have performed in the previous year.

Previously successful candidates may reapply for further annual grants during the duration of their course, but please note that a new application **MUST** be made each year. Applicants will be required to obtain written confirmation from their place of learning that they have taken up the offer of a placement.

Post Graduate students are no longer eligible for a grant.

The decision of the Trustees is final, and, as such, the Trustees are not empowered to enter into further discussion after a decision has been made.
