Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the NCFE Childcare and Development course, pupils have the opportunity to spend a childcare lesson at St Peters primary School or nursery to develop their understanding of the roles of early years workers. This is an exciting opportunity for pupils and gives them the opportunity to gain experience in the early years' classrooms.

Pupils will have access to the primary schools during their Child Development and Care lessons on Thursday morning. This will be on a rotation with the other members of the class, they will be told in advance when they are attending. Approximate timings for the activity:

- 8:35 Register as normal at QE
- 9am Sign out of QE and walk down to St Peters
- 9.15am Pupils will sign in at St Peters
- 11.15am Pupils sign out of St Peters and walk to school and be ready to learn in lesson 3

Pupils will be expected to represent the school by ensuring they follow school rules. I will be making them aware of rules regarding:

- Mobile phones, which should be turned off and follow the primary school's policy on storage
- Clothing: Pupils will be expected to be involved in all activities including time outside, therefore a warm coat, sensible shoes and trousers are suggested. Pupils will be expected to be wearing their correct QE school uniform
