## Re: The Duke of Edinburgh's Award

Congratulations to your son/daughter on successfully completing their Bronze DofE Award, pending their final presentation that is due during the first few weeks in September. They are now eligible to attempt their Silver Award.

The DofE has 3 progressive levels: Bronze, Silver and Gold. At Silver there remains four sections for your son/daughter to complete: physical, skill, volunteering and the expedition, however they have to commit longer periods of time to some of those sections (Volunteering = 6 months, Physical and Skills = one section for 6 months and the other for 3 months). The expedition is also longer and takes place over 3 days and 2 nights.

The cost for your son/daughter to undertake the Silver DofE award at QEHS is £175. This includes:

- Enrolment fee
- Campsite fees (for the practice and qualifying expeditions)
- Contributions towards the licensing fee and staff training costs
- Equipment hire and maintenance
- Administration charge (e.g. fuel, staff campsite fees, contingency, etc.)

In order to attempt the Silver Award students will need to commit to a series of DofE sessions through the year to plan routes and practice skills they may have forgotten since completing Bronze (please see the below timetable), and make themselves available for all expedition dates. Pupils must also meet the expectations outlined previously for the Bronze Award (i.e. being role models around school, completing certain sections prior to expeditions etc.).
