Applications are invited from students and apprentices for the academic year 2021/22 for a grant from the Foundation towards costs for attending university or college or participating in an apprenticeship

## Criteria

The Governors of the Foundation are able to make grants for the following purposes:

- Higher education at college, university or other educational establishments (including professional and technical)
- Financial assistance (on leaving school, college, university etc) to assist preparation for or entry into a professional, trade or calling, including the purchase of tools, instruments or books, membership to relevant professional bodies
- Travel in this country or abroad to pursue education
- Financial assistance for the study of music or other arts
- Otherwise to promote education including social and physical training

The Governors are required by the terms of the Foundation Scheme to give preference to applicants who are or have been students of Queen Elizabeth High School, Bromyard or its predecessors.

Therefore to qualify as beneficiaries within the terms of the Foundation Scheme applicants must:

- Have been born or be resident in the catchment area of the Queen Elizabeth High School, Bromyard, or its predecessors
- Be aged 18 to 25 years of age (or, in the case of apprenticeships 16-25)
