The governments current stance changed yesterday

"GCSE exams will take place in England during Summer 2021. The 2021 exam season has been delayed by three weeks, meaning most GCSE and vocational qualification exams will take place from 7th June to 2nd July."

- more generous grading than usual
- students getting advance notice of some topic areas covered in exams to focus revision
- exam aids such as formula sheets provided in some exams to cut down on the memorising required
- additional "backup" exams to be held in July to give students a second chance to sit a paper if they have to miss main exams or assessments due to illness or self-isolation



Importance of the Pre-Public Examinations

- There is a lot of uncertainty about what is going to happen in the summer. The school may be asked to provide teacher assessed grades and mock examination results.
- Will provide the school with a very accurate picture of where individual you are at in your journey towards achieving your potential
- The school and you will know which topic areas need to be revisited and strengthened
- The school has brought in qualified exam invalidators to conduct the exams
- Colleges and Sixth Forms will request these grades



Pre-Public Exams and COVID:19

- Students will be given the recommended space around them in which to complete their exams
- Students will all sit their exams in the gymnasium. Exams will be held in the Maths classrooms, staff offices and the gym
- If you are unable to sit a Pre-Public Examination because you isolating do not worry, there is a catch up plan for those students who may be affected
- No mobile phones in the exam if you are caught every student in a one desk area around you will be disqualified
