

Dear Parents and Carers,


This week, we remember those who served and continue to be in active service for our country, we honour their courage and cherish their memory.

What do you know about County Lines? Free training for parents and carers: The Ivison Trust (formerly known as Parents Against Child Exploitation (PACE)) are holding two evening seminars specifically for parents and carers in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough with a focus on County Lines and

<u>Scooter and bike sheds:</u> A reminder that we have a dedicated scooter park beyond the two bike sheds as you enter the school site. We politely request that pupils park scooters in the dedicated area to ensure enough room is within the bike sheds to park bikes. Thank you for your help.

#### **Cycle helmets:**

While it is not a legal requirement, The Highway Code suggests that cyclists should wear a helmet. We have noticed an increase in the number of children not wearing a cycle helmet and we would encourage parents to

consider the use of a cycle helmet for their child's safety.



<u>Suncream:</u> The UV rays are becoming greater in intensity and have been recorded at 4 this week. The recommendation for applying suncream from the Government and Cancer Research UK is when the UV levels are 3+. Parents and Carers are reminded to send sun cream into school with their child. Children will be reminded to

apply cream at lunchtime. Children should arrive on site already wearing suncream please. We recommend sunscreen sticks or lotions for easy application. Some pupils find the sprays tricky to use.

<u>Individual child fans:</u> We provide large fans in every classroom so would request individual fans are left at home please.

<u>Stanley water bottles:</u> Following my previous update about these water bottles, we have reviewed as a staff and conclude the bottle design is tricky as they are very unsteady when standing on pupil's desks. We would be grateful for any future purchases of water bottles to be 1 litre maximum. Thank you for your help.
