It follows a national government requirement to replace current district, county and city councils with single-tier councils.

<u>Three proposed options for reorganisation</u> were shared earlier this month. Council leaders now want to hear the views of residents, businesses and local stakeholders, like town and parish councils and community groups, to inform the development of these proposals.

An engagement survey has launched so people can share their thoughts on what priorities they think new unitary authorities should have and what is important to them when it comes to local government.


