It is worth considering the impact of vaping on children as there is increasing evidence suggesting that second hand smoke from vaping is harmful for those breathing it in.



#### Advice from UK HSA regarding Norovirus:

The UK is seeing extremely high levels of norovirus, with numbers far above the fiveyear average for this time of year. If you've caught the virus, take steps to avoid passing the infection on. **If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting, they must not return to school or nursery until 48 hours after their symptoms have stopped.** If you are unwell, avoid visiting people in hospitals and care homes to prevent passing on the infection in these settings.






