Activity Idea - Seaside Trifle You'll need-

- Blue Jelly.
- Fish jelly sweets.
- Whipped cream.
- Cake.
- Cocktail umbrella.
- A food safe jar.

Method-

- 1. Prepare the edible sand by breaking up the cake and placing it in the oven for 30 minutes to dry out. Allow it to cool, and then blend it in a food processor or break it up by hand until it reaches a fine crumb texture.
- 2. Make the jelly using the instructions on the packet and pour it into the jar so it's approximately 1/3 full and then add the fish sweets. Put the jar in the fridge to set.
- 3. Cover the jelly with whipped cream and then cover the cream with the edible sand.
- 4. Add a cocktail umbrella and Enjoy!
