Trial period for new routine at the end of the day for Year 3 and 4:

Following on from Mrs. Harrison's update to parents in October, we have been discussing and considering ways to streamline the collection of children at the end of the school day.

On Monday, we would like to commence a trial period where Year 3 and 4 will exit school using the same route that Year 5 and 6 currently use. Teachers will lead the Year 3 and 4 children through the red gates by the bottom car park. Once through the gates, class teachers will dismiss their children. We anticipate this will alleviate some of the current congestion experienced near the hall. We would be grateful for any feedback you have about this initiative during the trial period. If this does prove a successful modification, we will then put into place a second phase of our plan for Key Stage One and Reception.

Attendance:

Research has identified the better the attendance of a child at school, the better their academic progress. At The Rackham, we support wholeheartedly these findings about attendance and progress.

Arriving at school on time has also been shown to enhance academic progress. To ensure a child has the best chance of making good academic progress their attendance target would be 96% or above.

It seems sensible to share the following two paragraphs from our Attendance Policy:

Children should arrive at school from 8.30am and go straight to class. Registration is called at 8.45am. Registers will close five minutes after registration times.

A pupil that arrives after these times but before 9.15am will be marked as 'late'. Children who arrive after 9.15am will be marked as an unauthorised absence for that session although the school will know the child is on site for health and safety purposes such as a fire alarm.
