In maths, we have been exploring different ways to represent data. Each class has collected information such as their favourite ice cream flavour, and then shown their results in pictograms and bar charts. The children have also enjoyed solving an 'Nrich' Maths puzzle, which are put together by the University of Cambridge to challenge young mathematicians.

In topic this week, have been lucky enough to look at some real Roman artefacts, having borrowed some loan boxes from Ely museum. We were fascinated by how much we learnt while investigating different Roman objects. The children have then worked to create their own Roman object across our DT day, designing and making a Roman catapult. What a super end to a busy half term!
