- Added Apple Family
- Age-based parental controls, and they can use Family Sharing, Messages, the App Store and other Apple services.



#### New iPhone or iPad

- Use the child Apple ID to setup the device.
- The device will then appear in the Apple Family Screen.

#### Existing iPhone or iPad

Goto Settings and sign in with the child Apple ID



#### **Benefits**

Age-related restrictions for content in apps,
books, TV shows, and movies

- Downtime and limits for specific apps
- Restrictions for who your child can communicate with

- WhatsApp
- Facebook
- TikTok
- SnapChat
- These will all have Security features that will allow control and I would recommend to view these online
